Accident and Incident forms

# • Description

Accident and Incident forms are a mandatory health and safety requirement that enables us to monitor risks to both public and staff throughout our facility, it enables us to structure our training requirements and prioritises our Maintenance programme.

For most people physical activity should not pose any problem or hazard, however we must be aware of any accidents or incidents within the facility to ensure the health and safety of both staff and public.

# • If you do not give us your information

If you do not supply us with your information we will still record the accident or incident but will state that you did not wish to supply this information. Should you wish at a later date to pursue the accident or incident we will be unable to verify your claim.

We will be unable to follow-up on any accidents that resulted in being directed immediately to Hospital, or incidents involving lost items of value stolen and vehicles that have been damaged (as an example).

# • Conditions for processing personal information

Consent – we need to process this personal information to meet our obligation to staff and customers to ensure a safe environment. To fulfil our requirement to the Health & Safety Executive in recording and reporting accidents which result in a recommendation or immediate evacuation via Ambulance to the Hospital.

In the event of an emergency we may share your information with NHS Grampian and/or Police Scotland. Certain accidents are reportable under RIDDOR, in which case we will fulfil our obligation.
